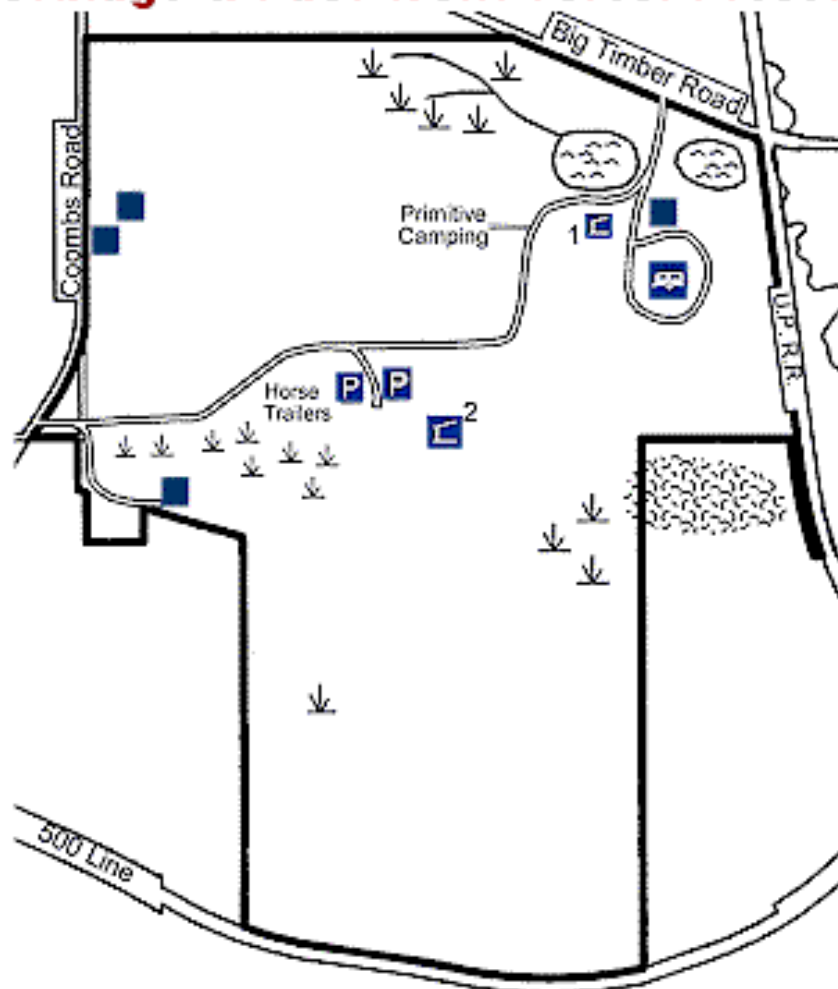

Use 1-90 from Rockford or from Chicago. Exit at Randall Road,
Go South to Big Timber Road. Turn right on Big Timber to Coombs Rd.
Turn left on Coombs Rd. to forest preserve entrance. Follow to parking lot and pavilion. **PLEASE DRIVE SAFELY!!!**

Please remember to clean up after your dog.

Dogs shall be on lead at all times.

Please review Chapter 1, Sec 16 of the Tracking Regulations

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable disease, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Tracking Test is for dogs not less than six months old. With the entry form for the TD Test of a dog which has not passed a "Tracking Test" there must be filed a written statement by a person who is accredited by the AKC to judge a "Tracking Test" that the dog is considered by the judge to be ready for such a test. An exhibitor may enter more than one dog. Entries without a Tracking Dog (TD) title or Tracking Dog Excellent (TDX) title will be accepted first.

The Tracking Dog Test will be limited to 4 Weimaraners. The Tracking Dog Excellent Test will be limited to 4 Weimaraners. If the limit is not reached in Weimaraners, other breeds may enter using the following procedure: Draw (1) Weimaraners without a TD or TDX title, Draw (2) Weimaraners with a TD or TDX title, Draw (3) Other breeds without a TD or TDX title, Draw (4) Other breeds with a TD or TDX title. If the limit for entries is not reached in one test and the limit is exceeded in the other test, the number of tracks will be exchanged up to the limit set by the AKC Tracking Regulations. Bitches in season may participate (refer to AKC Tracking Regulations, Chapter 2, Section 8, and notify Test Secretary prior to the drawing for track order on the day of the test).

There will be no actual scores for the TD or TDX Tests, but dogs will be rated "Passed" or "Failed" and TD or TDX certificates will be issued by the AKC confirming all dogs rated "Passed."

Telephone, facsimile, email, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries sent by overnight delivery service MUST include signature release.

ENTRY FEE is \$60.00 for the TD Test and \$100.00 for the TDX Test (includes 50 cents AKC Recording Fee) made payable to the Weimaraner Club of Northern Illinois in U. S. Funds.

IN ACCORDANCE with the AKC Obedience Regulations (Chapter 1,) ENTRIES in this TD/TDX test will be accepted up until the official closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached. A drawing will be held at the Arlington Heights Memorial Library, 500 North Dunton, Arlington Heights, IL 60004 on Thursday, November 1, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. to determine which entries will participate in the test. When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries, subject to the same preferences set forth above, will be similarly drawn and assigned a position on an alternate list. The Test Secretary will then notify all entries of the results of the draw. Entries will be acknowledged with a draw number and map and directions to the test site. There will be no drawing if the advertised limit is not reached.

IN THE EVENT that an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it will be the responsibility of the Test Secretary to determine if alternates are present, and to determine, by their position on the Alternate List, which alternates shall participate.

NO entry fee will be refunded except that of an alternate who does not participate in the test. Exception: In the event that an accepted entry withdraws from the test and an alternate replaces that entry, refund will be made to the withdrawn entry.

THE assignment of dogs to the tracks, by the drawing of lots, is the responsibility of the judges.

THE WEIMARANER CLUB OF NORTHERN ILLINOIS assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their children, dogs or property and children must be under the control of their parents or guardians.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times. (Please refer to AKC Tracking Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16.)
